Alleluia, alleluia! The Spirit of the Lord is upon me: he sent me to bring Good News to the poor. Alleluia!

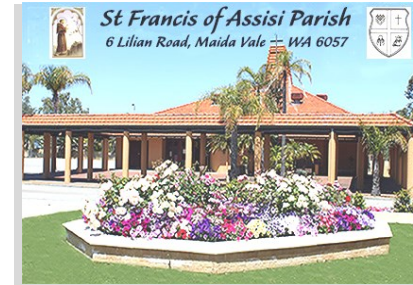
**Gospel** **Mark 6:1-6**

**Parish Centre Construction Update**

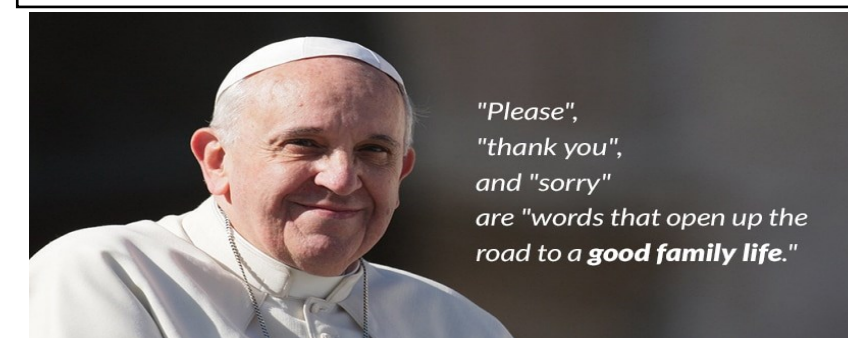


The painting of the ceilings and doors has been completed and the front doors installed.
