Renewing a WWC Card

"Child-related work carried out by an individual as a minister of religion or in any other capacity for the purposes of a religious organization"

WWC Cards are valid for **three** years. If you are continuing your child-related volunteer work you **must renew** your WWC Check before it expires. There are two ways to renew:

- complete and submit an online renewal form on the WWC Check website, if eligible; or
- complete a WWC Check application form and lodge it at authorised Australia Post outlet.

You should renew at least one month before your current WWC Card expires and no earlier than three months.

It is an offence to engage in child-related volunteer work when you do not have a current WWC Card. Fines of \$60 000 and imprisonment for 5 years apply.
