Parents who children are under the age of 18 years will need to fill out a Consent form, if you want your children to continue as volunteers. (choir for example)

Some volunteers will need to organised a Volunteer National Police Clearance and Working with Children Card according to the Screening Matrix: Catholic Archdiocese of Perth.
