FEAST OF DIVINE MERCY

(FIRST SUNDAY AFTER EASTER at 3:00PM | 27th April 2025)



As a further sign of His Forgiving Love, Jesus called for a Feast of Divine Mercy to be celebrated by the whole church. He said to St. Faustina: "I want this image to be solemnly Blessed on the first Sunday after Easter; that Sunday is to be The Feast of Mercy."

On that day, the depths of my Mercy are open to all. Whoever will go to confession and Holy Communion on that day will receive complete forgiveness of sin and punishment. Mankind will not enjoy peace until it turns with confidence to My Mercy.

THE DIVINE MERCY NOVENA

Jesus also asked that this Feast of Divine Mercy be preceded by a Novena to The Divine Mercy which would begin on Good Friday.

"On each day of the Novena you will bring to my Heart a different group of souls and you will immerse them in this ocean of my mercy".

Day 1 - 18 April | Good Friday: All mankind, especially sinners
(Immediately after the 3:00 PM Passion of Our Lord)

Day 2 - 19 April | Holy Saturday: The souls of priests and religious
(Immediately after the 7:00 PM Easter Vigil Ceremonies)

Day 3 - 20 April | Easter Sunday: All devout and faithful souls
(Immediately after the 9:30 AM Resurrection of the Lord)

(Tuesday & Thursday at 6:00 PM - After the Angelus)

Day 4 - 21 April | Monday: Those who do not believe in Jesus and those who do not yet know him
(Immediately after the 9:30 AM Holy Mass - Public Holiday)

Day 5 - 22 April | Tuesday: The souls of those who have separated themselves from my Church

Day 6 - 23 April | Wednesday: The meek and humble souls and the souls of little children
(During the Novena to Our Lady of the Miraculous Medal)

Day 7 - 24 April | Thursday: The souls who especially venerate and glorify my Mercy

Day 8 - 25 April | Friday: The souls who are detained in purgatory
(Immediately after the 9:30 AM Holy Mass)

Day 9 - 26 April | Saturday: The souls who have become lukewarm
(Immediately after the 9:30 AM Holy Mass)
